- 1. "Ellie Geranmayeh of the European Council on International Relations said on Twitter that the 'objective behind the killing wasn't to hinder (Iran's) nuclear programme but to undermine diplomacy," and the National Iranian American Council feels the same way:

- 2. The IDF "claimed the incidents were part of Israel's armed conflict with Hamas even if the protesters were largely unarmed civilians who took no part in hostilities":

- 3. "Israeli forces have a <u>long history</u> of attacking Palestinian medics and healthcare workers in the occupied territories. Last year, a <u>UN investigation</u> called the occupied Palestinian territories 'one of the most dangerous places in the world for healthcare workers'":

How Arab and Muslim-Americans may have helped Biden win Michigan

Polls show Muslim-Americans voted in record numbers in this week's still-contested US election.

Arab and Muslim voters turned out in unprecedented numbers in the US election and may have ultimately helped former Vice President Joe Biden secure victory in Michigan, according to polling results.

According to an exit poll from the Council on American-Islamic Relations, or CAIR - the largest civil rights organisation for US Muslims, well over one million American Muslims participated in the election.

The data indicates that 69 percent of US Muslims voted for Biden. Another 17 percent voted for President Donald Trump, four percentage points more than he received from the community in 2016.

"The Muslim community's significant ability to impact the results of numerous races across this country – including the presidential election – was recognized nationally by candidates and the media," said CAIR national executive director Nihad Awad.

CAIR's director of government affairs, Robert McCaw, said that there is "no denying" the important role that American Muslims now play in local, state and national politics.

As a symbolism, Joe Biden has declared that the Muslim Travel Ban would be lifted immediately.

US 'Muslim ban' set to end 'on day one' of Biden presidency

President-elect has pledged to immediately halt travel restrictions imposed by the Trump administration on more than a dozen nations.

On the first day of his presidency, president-elect Joe Biden intends to rescind Donald Trump's travel bans on travellers from 13 countries, most either majority-Muslim or African nations.

Shortly after taking office in 2017, Trump issued an executive order that banned travellers from seven majority-Muslim nations from entering the United States.

The Trump administration reworked the order several times amid legal challenges and the Supreme Court upheld a version of it in 2018. The countries subject to entry restrictions have changed over the years.

The bans could be easily undone as they were issued by executive order and presidential proclamation, according to policy experts, but lawsuits from conservatives could delay the process.

In October, Biden also promised to push politicians for laws to fight the surging number of hate crimes in the US.

"As president, I'll work with you to rip the poison of hate from our society to honour your contributions and seek your ideas. My administration will look like America with Muslim Americans serving at every level," he <u>said</u>.

Muslim voters want more than 'just a seat' at the table from President-elect Joe Biden

In the lead-up to the midterm election two years ago, Sara Deen noticed that many fellow Muslims in her South Bay community weren't voters. Some didn't understand the process. More lacked faith that their voice would matter or had trouble navigating a ballot.

She decided to prepare a voter guide and hand it out to friends and members of her mosque during Friday prayers. This year, she's seen an <u>increase in engagement from Muslim voters</u> — friends and acquaintances alike. They've asked for her help explaining state propositions, pored over her recommendations and debated their merits over WhatsApp and Zoom.

"I love it, and it means people are coming into their voice in my community," said Deen, a Rancho Palos Verdes resident. "But what's been disappointing is how often it feels like other politicians want to co-opt our voice but are not super interested in what we have to say."
